

## Factsheet Prater (status March 2023)

## History

 Once an imperial hunting ground and reserved only for the nobility, the Prater was made accessible to the Viennese as a recreational area from 1766 onwards. Gastronomy stands, restaurants, coffee houses, swings, merry-gorounds and bowling alleys were built within a short time.

In 1873 the first and only world exhibition in Vienna took place in the Prater. The center was a specially built 84 meter high rotunda with an impressive dome, which fell victim to a fire in 1937. The imposing rotunda, with a diameter of 108 meters, was the largest domed structure in the world at the time.

- In 1897 the Ferris Wheel was built. For entertainment there were a number of puppet theaters in simple wooden booths, of which the funny clown played a leading role. The Wurstelprater was also named after him.
- Large parts of the Prater were destroyed during World War II and then rebuilt after 1945 through private initiatives.
- 2023 150th anniversary of the World Exhibition in Vienna.
   Exactly 150 years ago the world exhibition takes place.
